ABOUT THE CAMPS

ELITE CAMP (grades 10 -12+)
Resident \$225/Commuter \$165
Session I: June 12 & 13
(Camp will run from 10 a.m. - 8 p.m. on June 12 and 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. on June 13)

This is a no-frills camp for the serious camper, designed to bring the best players together for top-notch competition. Fundamental skills will be taught. Campers should expect the sessions to be intense, physical and demanding. Fee includes t-shirt, prizes and all meals for resident campers; t-shirt, prizes, lunch and dinner for commuter campers.

JUNIOR ELITE CAMP (grades 7-9) \$175
Session II: June 14-16
(Camp will run from 9 a.m. - Noon and 1 p.m. - 4 p.m. daily;
Lunch from 12-1pm, MEALS NOT INCLUDED)

This camp focuses on fundamental shooting skills and team concepts. Camp structure includes individual fundamentals, games, competition, t-shirt, prizes and evaluations.

DAY CAMP (grades 3-6) \$175
Session III: June 19-21
(Camp will run from 9 a.m. - Noon and 1 p.m. - 4 p.m. daily;
Lunch from 12-1pm, MEALS NOT INCLUDED)

This camp focuses on fundamental basketball skills. Camp structure includes individual fundamentals, games, competition, t-shirt, prizes and evaluations.

These camps are open to any and all entrants — limited only by number, age, grade level, and/or gender.

RESIDENT FEES (Elite Camp only) The total registration fee must accompany all applications. Resident campers must provide their own linens, blanket, pillow, soap, towels and workout gear. Campers will be assigned housing in advance.

ROOMMATE REQUESTS (Elite Camp only) will be honored if possible. Campers are supervised days and evenings, and there is one staff counselor on every dorm floor throughout the night.

LOCATION Camps are held at the Kress Events Center on the UW-Green Bay campus. Campers should bring their own towel and a lock. No street shoes will be allowed in the gym.

CONFIRMATION Upon receipt of registration and total payment, a confirmation packet along with health and insurance forms will be EMAILED to you. These forms must be filled out and brought along to camp check-in.

REFUND POLICY/CANCELLATIONS A full refund will be given to an applicant if your application is received after the camp has reached the enrollment limit. Early cancellation due to a medical excuse will receive a full refund minus a \$25 cancellation fee if the cancellation is made in writing, prior to the start of camp and accompanied by a physician's statement. A camper departing camp due to an injury received at camp will receive a prorated refund, minus a \$25 cancellation fee. All other cancellations will receive payment back minus a \$50 cancellation fee if notification is made at least one week prior to the start of camp. NO refunds will be given for no-shows or campers sent home for disciplinary reasons. Allow up to four weeks for refund processing.

MEALS (Elite Camp only) will be served in the University Union dining room, located on campus.

INSURANCE Campers are required to have their own health insurance policy. Health and medical authorization forms will be emailed to you with your confirmation packet. A physical is not required for these camps.

HEALTH SERVICES CPR-certified first-responders are on staff. Emergency service is on call at all times.

HEAD COACH KEVIN BORSETH

Under Kevin Borseth, the Phoenix continues to surpass expectations. In addition to winning its 18th consecutive conference championship, the end of the 2016 season also saw the Phoenix finish 13th in the WBCA National Academic Honor Roll. Kaili



Lukan was named the Horizon League Defensive Player of the Year, along with Mehryn Kraker and Jessican Lindstrom earning all-league honors as well. Green Bay made an appearance in the NCAA tournament for the seventh time in eight years. The 2016-2017 season picked up right where the previous season left off, including an appearance in the WNIT Pre-season Tournament semi-final game against #1 ranked Notre Dame, an NCAA RPI ranking as high as #3 in the nation,

and an appearance ranked in the AP and USA Today Top 25. The Phoenix also won it's conference opening game for the 29th year in a row.

During the Kevin Borseth years, Green Bay has advanced to the postseason in all thirteen seasons, including ten trips to the NCAA Tournament. The Phoenix also won the regular season conference championship in each of his thirteen seasons at the helm. All told, the 28-year head coaching veteran has an impressive record of 635-255 in his stints at Michigan Tech (1987-1998), Green Bay (1998-2007, 2012-pres) and Michigan (2007-2012).

During his time at Green Bay, Borseth has been named the conference coach of the year eight times and led the program to its first two NCAA Tournament victories with wins over Washington in 2003 and New Mexico in 2007.

Borseth coached a number of the most legendary players in the program's storied history, including the top two all-time leading scorers, Chari Nordgaard and Nicole Soulis. He also recruited recent standouts Celeste Hoewisch, Kayla Tetschlag, Julie Wojta and Adrian Ritchie to Green Bay. Borseth and his wife Connie have five children; KC, Kayla, Carli, Kaitlyn and Kale.
